Shift 1 - supporting diverse learners through interventions to focusing on strengthening instructional core

- Shared Curriculum
 - TC Units of Study for Reading and Writing
 - Envisions Math
- Daily lesson plan - unit planning - yearly (Next Gen standards)

Shift 4 - Shift from Using One-Size-Fits-All Professional Development to Creating Context for 21st Century Adult Learning
